RAG of the Impact on Exhibitors Attending The Show:

- R** Significant Impact - some exhibitors will not be able to attend²
- A** Medium Impact - some exhibitors may not be able to attend²
- G** Minimal impact - show can proceed with all exhibitors¹

Notes:

1. Assuming all published DEFRA & APHA rules are followed where applicable e.g. CPH, Movement Licence (General or Special) and Pre-Movement testing
2. As previously stated, if any exhibitor is unable to take part due to a change in the movement rules that makes attendance impossible then a refund of pen and entrance fees will be given.
3. We have requested that the requirement for Pre-Movement testing is removed given the unique nature of the Show i.e. direct movement to and from and undercover venue during an SVLP period. Until we hear back in the positive however then herds within the restricted zone must plan on carrying out Pre-Movement testing within the 21 day window. If the requirement to conduct Pre-Movement testing was removed there may be an exception for pregnant females who would still require testing - in this instance exhibitors may be offered the opportunity to substitute an alternative non-pregnant animal otherwise the entrance fee for the pregnant female would be refunded.
4. Any herds currently outside of an RZ that wanted to mitigate the risk of their area being added to the RZ in the 21 days prior to the Show and assuming that the Showground remained outside an RZ could consider private testing in order that they could apply for a Movement Licence quickly if the need arose.
5. **It is imperative that all alpacas attending the Show have correct and functioning microchips checked prior to travelling to the Show**, notwithstanding being required alongside Ear Tag numbers for any Movement licence application.
